We will be learning:

In science, we will be learning about the basic parts of the human body and the parts of the body associated with each sense. We will be identifying and naming a variety of plants and flowers and learning the difference between types of trees.

In DT we will be using different materials to build free standing towers.

In geography we will be creating weather charts to record the weather and learn about the different seasons.

In art, we will be experimenting with different colour mixing and painting.

In music, we will be listening to different types of music and discussing what we think and how we feel about them.
