## **Early Years**

This month Hedgehog Nursery children have been learning about the Polar regions. We have made shape penguins and polar bears and had fun using sugar cubes to make igloos.

In Monkey Nursery we started the month learning about winter. We explored what changes we can see around us during winter and how the weather changes. The children learnt about how ice is made and what happens to it as it gets warm. We have also started our new core story 'The Train Ride' and have been learning about the different parts of a train and what they are for. In phonics we have started learning about syllables and how to count the number of beats we can hear as we say different words.

Reception have been focusing on Arctic themed learning, we have been learning about Arctic animals, finding out about the Northern Lights and making our own wintry themed music. The children have been working really hard to learn the new phase three sounds and have also continued their number recognition focusing on numbers six to ten. We have also been ensuring we understand the value of each number and how they link to one another.







#### **Key Stage 1**

In KS1 we have been learning all about robots. In English we shared what we already know about robots and wrote some questions of things we would like to find out. We have been looking at non-fiction texts and have written our own information texts about robots. In DT, we designed a robot, and then used junk modelling to make it. In maths we have been learning about multiplication and division and have been working out the answers to questions in the 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables. In PE the children have been doing gymnastics, learning to make shapes and balances and transferring their skills onto the large apparatus. In History we have been looking at the history of technology and how transport has changed over time.
