We have had an amazing June learning about a whole variety of different things across the school...

Early Years













In June Hedgehog class have been reading the story Hooray for Fish and leaning all about the creatures and fish that live in the oceans. The children created their own clay fish, made jelly fish and pretended to move like sea creatures whilst enjoying being outside in the lovely weather. As we approach the end of the school year, we will also be learning about the people that help us and spending time getting to know our new teachers and exploring our new classroom.

Monkey class have been finding out all about life under the sea and what creatures lurk beneath! In July, we will be learning all about people who help us and we hope to have some special surprise visitors!

In Reception we have been continuing our phonics learning and have moved onto phase 4 words, in maths we have been doubling and halving numbers and working hard to recall number bonds to ten. For our topic work we have been finding out about SeaLife creatures and completing some SeaLife themed art, we have also been using our imaginations just like Billy does in our core story. Over the next few weeks we will be starting to think about transitions and talking about Year One. We will also be enjoying lots of lovely summer weather (hopefully) for outdoor learning week.

Year 1's have been looking at 2D and 3D shapes in Maths, naming them and discussing their properties. In Computing, we have used the app ScratchJnr to programme a 'Sprite' by giving it specific instructions.

We celebrated the children's achievements in their races for our 2nd Sports day. We have also completed activities we missed due to the hot weather last week in our P.E lessons.

We have had Talent show auditions in our classes, and supported the finalists in the school hall.

In English, we have been using persuasive language to encourage people to look after bees and how to keep their homes safe.
