




Watton Westfield Infant and Nursery School - Newsletter Friday 1st December 2023

In phonics we have continued to develop our listening skills through different games and explored how we can use our voices to make different sounds-this was really useful when retelling 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'

## Reception

Reception have started our celebrations topic, we have learnt about bonfire night



and divali and enjoyed our divali dancing with a visitor who came to visit us for this. We have been continuing our phonics work and are trying to read CVC (three letter words), we are having a go at writing them too. In Math's we have been continuing our work on number composition and using five frames to support this.

#### KS1

In Key Stage 1 we have been reading our core story Traction Man is Here. We have explored materials and their properties in Science through using fair tests. In Math's we have been looking at addition and subtraction and shape across Years 1 and 2. In D & T we are exploring wheels and axels to make our own moving vehicles. In computing we are exploring the Paintz app, creating posters and art work. In History we learned about the Gunpowder Plot and the involvement of Guy Fawkes. In RE we are learning about the Nativity. We are also practicing hard to put on a sp
