Islam	The religion of the Muslims.
The Prophet Muhammad	The Arab founder of Islam, Muhammad is held by Muslims to be the chief prophet of Allah (God).
The Mount of Olives	The Mount of Olives is a mountain ridge east of and adjacent to Jerusalem's Old City It is named for the olive groves that once covered its slopes.
Mount Hira	Near the top is a small cave known as the Cave of Hira It was here that the Prophet Muhammad received the first revelations of the Holy Quran.
Mosques	A Muslim place of worship.
Sikhism	The religion of the seeks.
Gurdwara	A Sikh place of worship.

Area	Information
Special Places	That we might have special places where we like to go where we find peace and calm. That religious people have special places where they feel connected to their religion and have religious significance e.g. places of pilgrimage.
Islam	Learning about the Prophet Muhammad's early life and that the Angel Gabriel spoke to him and that Allah sent down the Qur'an to him.
Sikhism	Learning about the Gurus and their teachings. The definition of a Sikh person. Sikh practices.
Gurdwara	The Gurdwara means 'Residence of the Guru' or 'the door that leads to the Guru'. In the modern Gurdwara the Guru is the scriptures.
