In English we will be learning to:

- Make predictions using the text to support.
- Explore the emotions of characters and how these are shown through actions and word choices.
- Use expanded noun phrases in our writing.
- Create information posters

Ongoing daily skills:

- Daily 1:1 reading and story sharing.
- Using appropriate punctuation.
- Handwriting practice
- Precision Teaching for Reading /

Our SEMH focus will include:

- Exploring the core emotions through individualised ELSA sessions.
- Sensory pathways.

We will also be learning about:

Science:

- Describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as approximately spherical bodies.
- Describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system.
- Use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the Sun across the sky.
- Describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth.

Art:

- To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, in this case Papier Mache.
- To improve their understanding of colour mixing and the secondary colours.

Cooking:

- Pupils can weigh out a range of ingredients.
- Use different mixing techniques
- Understand the importance of good food hygiene.
