In Art we will be create a collage using the core story as our inspiration. We will use mixed media to create different effects.

In Music, we will be using instruments to make rainforest sounds.

In PE we will be learning gymnastics.

In Computing, we will be thinking about how to stay safe when we are using the internet. We will also be practising our key board skills.


