Keeping children safe

All staff are employed under safer recruitment guidelines and are trained in safeguarding and promoting the welfare of young people.

All children should be able to go to school and feel safe so that they can achieve their very best. Unfortunately, there may be occasions when a concern has been raised. If you need to report something that worries you, please speak to one of our designated safeguarding leads who are named on the reverse of this page.

What parents must do:

- Feel confident to raise concerns about your child
- Send your child to school on time, every day.
- Talk to school if you need help or support
- Read the school policies about safety issues

Let the school know:

- If your child has a medical condition or a change in medical condition
- If you have any court orders relating to the safety of your child
- If there is a change in your circumstances such as a house move, change of name, change of parental responsibility
- Who will be collecting your child

What visitors must do:

- Follow safeguarding procedures on site at all times
- Report any concerns immediately to a designated safeguarding lead
