

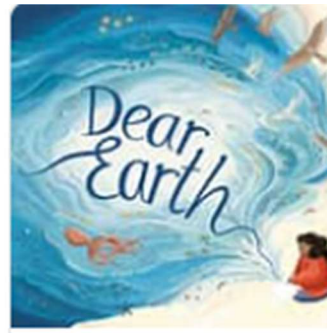
Team Aldrin Overview, (Autumn 2, 2024 – 2025)

In English we will be learning to:

- To understand what a non-fiction text is and how this differs from a fiction.
- To use subordination and coordination conjunctions
- Use expanded noun phrases in our writing.

Ongoing daily skills:

- Using appropriate punctuation including apostrophes for contraction and possessive apostrophes.
- Handwriting practice
