Please leave all prams and buggies outside and sit younger siblings on your knee. If you have any mobility needs and require assistance with access or seating, please speak to your child's teacher before the performance date and we will do our best to help.

Doors will open approximately 15 minutes prior to the start of the performances.

It is school policy that photography is permitted, but we ask that you focus on your own child and **do not share any images taken in school on social media**. Failure to comply to this will mean you will be asked to remove images, and we may not be able to allow photography at events in the future.

Once the performances are finished the children will return to their classes with their teacher. We will ask the audience to wait while the children file out of the hall before you depart, please. If it is an afternoon performance, you may be able to take your child early but will need to wait for them to be ready. Siblings from other classes cannot leave early as this is too disruptive.
