How you can help me at home:

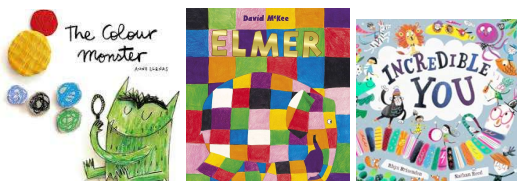
- Sing nursery rhymes together.
