In maths we will be learning to:

- Understand multiplication
- Know how to multiply a 1-digit number by a two-digit number
- Recall 7- and 11-times table and notice patterns within these tables.
- Recognise features of 2D shapes.

In English we will be learning to:

- Discussion and recording of ideas
- Organising paragraphs around a theme.
- Use simple organisation devices (headings / subheadings) in a non- fiction text.



Rocks and fossils

- Compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties.

- Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.
- Recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.

Geography:

- Understand the key aspects of physical geography – underneath the Earth's surface.
- Understand and explain how volcanoes are formed
- Explain the causes of earthquakes and how to stay safe during one.
