In English we will be learning to:

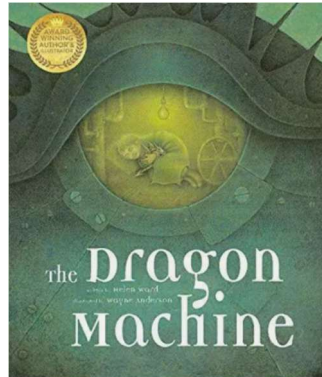
- Understand how prefixes and suffixes are used and how they alter the meanings of words.
