# **Curriculum News**

### **Nursery:**

This half term in Hedgehogs we have been leaning about different types of vehicles. Hedgehog children have really enjoyed going to the school woods every Wednesday and they can all now manage putting on their outdoor rain clothing and welly boots independently. Well done Hedgehogs!

In Squirrels we have used stories, such as 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt', 'Handa's Surprise', 'Mr Gumpy's Outing' and 'Whatever Next' to explore different journeys. We have also been learning to make comparisons between objects relating to size, length, weight and capacity. Next half term we will be looking at what we can find in our gardens, looking at flowers, bugs and birds.

#### Reception:



During March in Reception we have explored the life cycles of humans and chickens, and written instructions describing how to grow a plant. We have learnt how to double in Maths and how to combine numbers to make 7. In PE we have been doing gymnastics, learning to improve our balancing and jumping skills. Next half term we will be learning about Traditional Tales.

### Year 1:

In Year 1 we have been reading the vehicle text; 'Where the Wild Things Are'. We have written a portal narrative to retell the story, created our own 'Wild Thing' and written a fact file about it. We had a DT day and learnt about healthy eating and tried some different fruit and vegetables. We designed a kebab or smoothie and then we used the skills we had learnt to cut the fruit and veg and make our healthy snack. We also had our trip to Gressenhall and learnt about 'farm to food'. This involved learning about



wheat and what food products this makes. We got a tractor ride around the farm and got to meet the animals who live there. Next half term we will be learning about weather in the UK and farming.

# Year 2:

This half term in Year 2 in English we have been reading 'Grandad's Island'. We have been writing our own narrative of our character's travel to an island and having to experience the loss of leaving someone behind. In Maths, we have been learning about money, including making the same amount in different ways and giving change. We have also moved onto fractions and have learnt about 'half'. In Topic, we have been learning about the world, naming the seven continents and the five oceans. In R.E, we have learnt about the Seder plate in Judaism and what each food symbolises for Passover. Next half term we will be learning about life in a castle and online safety.

We are all looking forward to the days getting brighter and warmer.


