

Curriculum News

Here is a round up of this half term and the fun and learning we have enjoyed:

This half term in Hedgehog Nursery we have been settling into our new class, making friends and exploring our topic of All About Me. After half term we will learning all about colours and celebrations.





The children in Squirrel Nursery have done well settling in and making new friends. We have enjoyed learning about ourselves, our emotions and talking about who is in our families. We have also done activities linked to Autumn and enjoyed making clay hedgehogs. In Maths we have learnt about different colours, matching/sorting objects and in phonics we have learnt about environmental and instrumental sounds. Next term the key focus will be linked to celebrations, including fireworks, Children in Need and Christmas. In Phonics we will learn about body percussion, voice and instrumental sounds. In Maths we will learn about subitising, introducing

In Reception we have been beginning our reading journey by learning the first sets of sounds. We have been practising oral blending to help us hear and read words. In Maths we have been learning to 'subitise using our fast eyes', which means recognising a quantity without counting. We have also been learning to retell a story about a boy called Dan who loses a ball down a hole. We have been using the balance bikes and have been learning how to move in space in PE.

1, introducing 2 and learning about patterns.





Year 1 have had a busy and exciting time in class! In Maths, we've been learning to order numbers from 0–10 and exploring the concepts of more than, less than, and equal to. In English, we've been reading *Old Bear* and writing our own versions by focusing on the opening, build-up, problem, and ending. In PE, the children have been developing their throwing and catching skills. Our History lessons have focused on comparing toys from the past with those we play with today. In Art, we've been creating shapes using different media, including paint, wax crayons, and pencils. Well done, Year 1!

In Year 2, we have been learning about writing a twisted tale, an alternative version to a traditional tale of Jack and the Beanstalk. We have also been learning how to write a persuasive letter. In Maths, we have been learning about place value, understanding how many tens and ones are in a number and making these numbers using different resources. We have also been learning about the value of each coin and how to add coins and notes together. In P.E, we have been learning different ball skills and in Science, we have been learning about what different animals need for survival. We designed a poster on how to keep our teeth healthy and we designed a healthy lunchbox.
