- To understand multiplication including formal method of short and long multiplication.
- We will explore factor pairs and the product of these factors
- To be able to recall 4's and 8's timetables confidently.
- To be able to use coordinates in all four quadrants.

We will also be learning about:

Science:

- Explore different sounds and how they are made.
- To be able to explain how vibrations are made.
- Understand the parts of the ear and explain the roles they play on hearing sound.
- Carryout a fair test involving volume

Our SEMH focus will include:

- Exploring the core emotions through individualised ELSA sessions.
- Therapeutic Story Writing sessions
- Mindfulness and relaxation techniques.
- Lego based Therapy to develop communication and resilience.
- Sense of self
- Neuroscience – the hand brain model

In English we will be learning to:

- We will write diary entries, instructional texts and discussion texts.
- Children will apply their growing knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes (morphology and etymology).
- We will make predictions about what or who they think the origami creature is.
- We will learn to use paragraphs and a range of cohesive devices: such as on the other hand, in contrast, or as a consequence.
