Foundation Subjects:

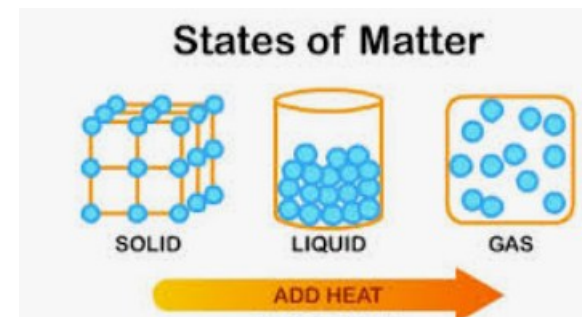
Art/DT: We are going to be exploring a range of media to create a Southern Lights picture.
