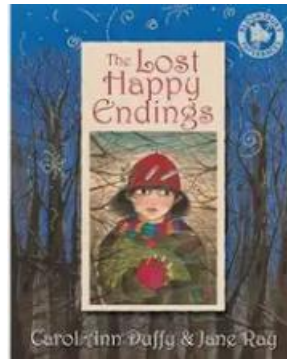


In maths we will be learning to:
