Key skills for your child:

- Being able to speak in full sentences.
- Being able to zip up a coat and put on hats, scarves and gloves.
- Holding a pencil correctly to form their letters.
- Writing their name.
- Being able to follow instructions.
- Able to share and take turns.
- Blending CVC words when reading.
- Recognise numbers and quantities to 5.

At home you could...

- Encourage your child to put on their winter clothing independently (Zip up coats, put on gloves etc.)
- Hear your child read as often as possible.
- Help your child to write the letters that we have been learning.
- Read lots of stories and encourage the children pick out letters and words they recognise. Can they find the title of the book?
- Count everything around you.
- Play with resources to develop fine motor control, such as Lego, pegs, playdough, painting.
