

In maths we will be learning about:

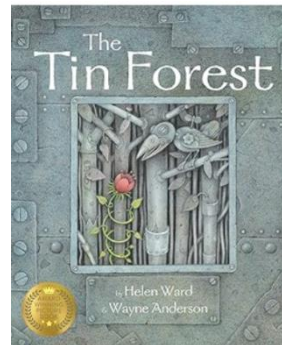
- Identifying angles as a series of turns
