- Learn formal methods for addition and subtractions
- Multiplying decimals and whole number by 10, 100 and 1,000
- Perimeter including different units of measure.

In English we will be learning to:

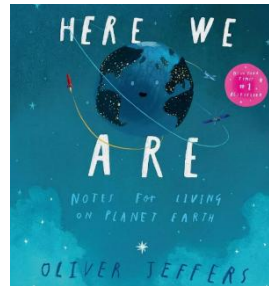
- Make predictions using evidence from the text.

- Use expanded noun phrases in our writing.
- Use apostrophes for contractions
- Plan and write an information text

Our SEMH focus will include:

Science:

- Describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth.

Art:

- To improve their understanding of colour mixing and the secondary colours.

Cooking:

- Pupils can weigh out a range of ingredients in grams and kilograms.
- Use different mixing techniques
- Understand the importance of good food hygiene.
