In Maths we will be learning to:

- Represent numbers up to 100 in different ways
- Find numbers on a number line and use this to find more and less
- Partition numbers
- Identify and name 2D shapes
- Discuss the features of 2D shapes

In English we will be learning to:

- Ask questions about the text, using question marks correctly
- Using adjectives to describe nouns
- Rehearse and perform a story
- Retell a narrative in our own words

Ongoing daily skills:

- Daily 1:1 reading and story sharing.
- Using appropriate punctuation.
- Handwriting practice
- Fluency practice
- Precision Teaching to support our reading and spelling

Science:

- Look at the artwork of Orla Kiely
- Design our own printing block to create repeating patterns

- To create and perform our own pieces of music

- Use different mixing techniques
- Understand the importance of good food hygiene
